The use of working animals began long before humankind started to practice agriculture, which is the way people grow plants. The use of animal power is now considered by many people to be inefficient. Yet, despite the more than years spent promoting using machines in developing countries, the development gap between industrialized countries and those with weak, highly dependent economies has increased. Moreover, the use of existing production models, which are more seriously dependent on fossil fuels, cannot be considered possible round the world. Therefore, other energy sources such as the effective use of working animals must be established. Animals not only provide the means by which millions of families make a living, but they also contribute to socially acceptable production systems. Besides, the efficiency of their energy inputs into crop production is higher than that of machines. This means the traditional use of working animals has the potential to improve the living conditions of farmers.
