Khajeh Shamseddin Mohammad Hafez-e Shirazi is regarded as one of the greatest Persian poets of all time. He was born in Shiraz about seven centuries ago (between the year 1310 and 1337 A.D). When he was a child, he received religious education. People called him Hafez (a title which was given to those who had memorized the Holy Quran by heart). He had memorized the Quran by listening to his father's recitations of it. He also had memorized many of the works of his hero, Saadi, Attar and Nezami. Hafez married in his twenties and he had a child. Hafez is mostly known and appreciated for a special type of poetry that is called Ghazal. Emotions and ethics are used in Ghazals a lot. All his poems are collected in a book that is called Divan. It has been translated into countless languages including German, English and French. Hafez is said to be the inspiration for many poets and authors around the world. He died at the age 69.
