




The most successful and the most popular of <u>these</u> is a language called Esperanto .It was invented by Ludwig Zamenhof , who lived on Poland .When he was growing ,he saw that people from different backgrounds who lived in Poland had lots of difficulties communicating with each other. This often led to disagreements. He didn't use his real name. He used the name Dr. Esperanto (which means "one who hopes"). Soon people from all over the world became interested in his language, called Esperanto. Today Esperanto is spoken by eight million people throughout the world. Many governments and international organizations recognize it in many ways. Esperanto is often used on radio broadcasts from official government stations.
